This month we have been carrying out patrols in the area and carrying out some reassurance visits to members of the neighborhood who have reported some activity and incidents within the ward.

Priorities

- Reassurance patrols around ORCHARD WAY to deter ASB and provide crime prevention advice on motor vehicle theft.
- Increased patrols around LONGHEATH GARDENS due to a slight rise in ASB
- Increased patrols around ASHBURTON PLAYING FIELDS due to reports of increased ASB involving youths.

CRIMES REPORTED

Below is some of the crimes that have been reported for July 2023

Theft of motor vehicle , 02/07/2023 , 19:00-14:30 next day, ELDON AVENUE

- unknown suspect entered vehicle and stole personal valuables without using any keys

Criminal damage vehicle, 01/07/2023– 02/07/2023 , 18:00 - 10:00, LONGHEATH GARDENS

- Damage to wing mirror of vehicle

Theft from motor vehicle, 05/07/2023, 12:00-13:45, DAISY CLOSE

- Suspect gained entry to victims vehicle by breaking in using the rear door handle and stealing valuables

Attempted robbery, 06/07/2023, 16:35, ORCHARD WAY

- Suspect approached victim and demanded phone. Thankfully suspect wasn't able to carry the robbery out.

Vehicle Interference, 18/07/2023, WILKS GARDENS

- Suspects riding 3 mopeds attempted to steal victims bike using an angle grinder, suspects fled the scene before police arrived leaving the bike but damaging the lock.

ADVICE

We have had an increasing amount of residents concerned around potential theft especially around motor vehicles. Where possible we recommend fitting vehicles with a steering lock and a dash cam to help deter any attempt and capture any footage of repeat concerns.

We have also had reports of noise complaints coming from neighbours as always these can be reported to the team, however the first port of call should be with the local council regarding any noise disputes who can be emailed on pollution@croydon.gov.uk Finally we have had a slight rise of anti social behaviour and residents have asked about CCTV regarding their property. For this we recommend using something such as ring doorbell, and if using larger CCTV systems please be mindful of invading other neighbours privacy.
