

From Myself and the team we hope this letter finds you well,. Here is the newsletter for crimes that have happened for September 2023 to provide some information and advice in relation to reports we have received.

This month we have been carrying out patrols in the area, in particular focusing on priority areas such as Stroud green way, Wickham Road and Longheath Gardens and carrying out some reassurance visits to members of the neighborhood who have reported some activity and incidents within the ward.

We also had our street briefing at Wickham Road and our drop in service at Longheath Gardens Community centre.

CRIMES REPORTED

Priorities

- Increased patrols around DELAMARE CRESCENT due to reports of theft from and of motor vehicles .
- Weapon sweeps and reassurance patrols around SHOREHAM CLOSE
- Increased patrols around SHIRLEY OAKS ROAD

Below is some of the crimes that have been reported for September 2023.

VERDAYNE AVENUE 02/09/2023 THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

Vehicle stolen without the use of any keys, vehicle was not fitted with a tracker.

BARMOUTH ROAD 04/09/2023 THEFT OG MOTOR VEHICLE

Moped stolen from location between 1600 and 0200, no CCTV, and no suspects seen or heard.

DELAMARE CRESCENT 04/09/2023 THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

Vehicle broken into over night, suspects took the dash cam and some loose coins left in the centre compartment.

CHAFFINCH AVENUE 05/09/2023 ROBBERY FROM PERSON

Victim had mobile phone stolen whilst on there way home from school.

BYWOOD AVENUE 19/09/2023 BURGLERY FROM RESIDENTIAL

3 suspects were parked up in a vehicle, and shortly after gained entry to the house through the front door. Kitchen was searched and valuables stolen along with a box believed to contain vehicle keys, however vehicle was unlocked on driveway and was also searched by suspects.

WICKHAM ROAD 22/09/2023 ROBBERY FROM PERSON

Victim was assaulted whilst waiting at the bus stop, victim also had phone stole during the assault.
