CRIMES REPORTED

Below is some of the crimes that have been reported for December 2023.

STOCKBURY ROAD 04/12/2023 RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

Victim returned home to find door unsecure, door looked to be forced open with a chisel, no suspects identified but item of clothing left behind at the scene.

SPRING LANE 04/12/2023 ATTEMPTED ROBBERY

Victim left the bus and was approached by 2 youths asking what phone he had, they proceeded to attack the victim before a member of the public intervened and scared them off before they could commit the robbery.

WATLINGS CLOSE 08/12/2023 VEHICLE INTERFERENCE

Suspects unlocked victims vehicle and then walked off where suspect had another vehicle waiting for them, vehicle wasn't stolen and no suspect identified.

SHIRLEY ROAD 05/12/2023 THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

Victim left vehicle unattended with the keys in whilst going inside a shop, Vehicle was stolen and no suspects identified.

WOODMERE AVENUE 12/12/2023 THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

Victims vehicle was stolen from their drive, no suspect identified.

LONGHEATH GARDENS 12/12/2023 THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

Victim had number plates stolen from vehicle that was stored in a nearby carpark, no suspect identified.

ADVICE

We are still seeing a large amount of theft from motor vehicles, these are mainly people trying to steal number plates or the vehicles themselves, please consider using steering wheel locks and never leave your vehicle unlocked and unattended even for a few minutes.

With a large amount of phone robberies consider obtaining your IMEI number which can be obtained from your network provider, this will help us to locate and identify your phone should it be needed.
