# **CRIMES REPORTED**

Below is some of the crimes that have been reported for June 2025

### **KNOLE CLOSE 03/06/2025 CRIMINAL DAMAGE**

Victim reporting that they parked the car outside Knole close after work, and in the morning found that the rear passenger window smashed. No signs of anyone entering the vehicle.

# REGENCY WALK 08/06/2025 THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

Unknown suspects have stolen the victims vehicle overnight from where it was parked. No further evidence available.

# **RUSTHALL CLOSE 10/06/2025 THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE**

Unknown suspects stole victims motorcycle overnight, no CCTV available and suspects have not been identified.

# **LONGHEATH GARDENS 11/06/2025 THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE**

Victim had vehicle stolen overnight, it was stated that the vehicle was un-drivable and would have had to of been towed or lifted.

### **KEATS WAY 16/06/2025 ATTEMPTED BURGLARY**

Suspects attempted to gain entry by trying to open the front door whilst the victim was in the front room, however was scared off by the victims dog, the suspect tried again a few minutes later but was again scared off with no further attempts made.

As you can see from the short list of examples above theft of motor vehicle continues to be an issue especially overnight thefts. Please take necessary precautions such as security lighting, wheel clamps and CCTV or please reach out to the team for further advice.
